If a student is able to bypass foreign language classes because of placement, any hours not transcribed must be made up in elective credits in order to bring the total number of semester credit hours for the degree to no fewer than 120.

Courses taken at Lee College will not transfer as Upper Level credits.

The last 30 hours of coursework must be completed at UHD. Of the coursework completed at UHD, 18 hours must be upper-level.

Check with your advisor how requirements from the Associate of Arts, the Associate of Science, and the Associate of Applied Science may be applied.

All students must take and pass the Writing Proficiency Exam. See the UHD catalog for more information.
