

FAQ's

- What are the minimum GPA and/or testing requirements to transfer to UHD?
UHD is an open-enrollment institution, which means there are no GPA or testing requirements to transfer to UHD.
- Does UHD have an application deadline?
No. However, you are encouraged to submit your paperwork early so that you can register before the registration deadlines.
- How many transfer hours will UHD accept?
Generally, you can transfer a maximum of 66 hours of your community college course work. There is no limit of credit hours from 4 year institutions.
- How do I determine which of my classes will transfer to UHD?
The UHD website lists course equivalencies from several local community colleges. An official transcript evaluation will be completed once you are admitted.
- When can I see an advisor?
Once you have been admitted, you will see an academic advisor who will review your transcripts and assist you with your course selection. Advising is done on a walk-in basis.
- Can I attend UHD and another university or college at the same time?
Yes. Be sure to send an official transcript of your other course work to UHD at the end of the semester. If enrolled in another institution make sure you obtain approval from your academic advisor.
