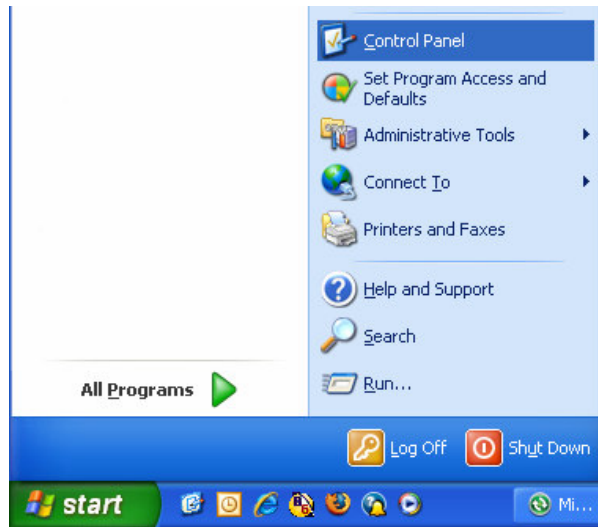


Microsoft Internet Explorer is currently available for Download in stand alone format or via Windows Update. The following instructions will guide you through the removal process of Internet Explorer 7, rolling you back to Internet Explorer 6

**Step 1:** Begin by clicking on the **Start menu** and clicking and then selecting **Control Panel**.



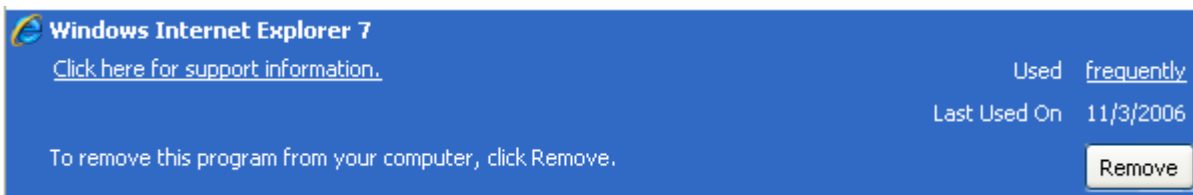
**Step 2:** In the **Control Panel** window, open **Add or Remove Programs**



**Step 3:** When the **Add or Remove Programs** dialog window appears, check the box at the top of the window labeled “**Show Updates**”



**Step 4:** Scroll through the **Add or Remove Programs** dialog windows until you find “**Windows Internet Explorer 7**”, and click the button labeled **Remove**.



**Step 5:** Once you click remove you will be prompted to confirm that you want to uninstall Internet Explorer 7. A short wizard will run, and you will be prompted to restart your computer. Upon restarting you should be successfully rolled-back to Internet Explorer 6
